# A GREEN TRANSFORMATION IS UNDERWAY TO PRESERVE OUR JEWEL OF INTERNATIONAL TOURISM:


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



The estate is close to the village of Lourmarin, ranked as one of the "Most Beautiful Villages in France".

Visit of Bonnieux - a beautiful hilltop village on the northern slope of the Luberon range, across from the village of Lacoste. Enjoy a stroll through the charming village streets. At a restaurant or café, savour the easy-going Provençal way of life. Right at the **heart of the Apt area**, the world capital of candied fruit, enjoy **a visit to the House of Candied Fruit**, Europe's first museum solely dedicated to candied fruit.

plant, where some 1,000 tons of ochre were extracted each year between 1921 and 1963. The cleaning systems, kiln and windmills have been restored so that visitors can see how the mineral was processed. **Visit of Ménerbes and the Truffle House**.

Visit of the Lavender Museum

introduces you to all aspects of lavender – how it is grown, its history, properties, qualities and future.

#### Visit of Gordes and Sénanque Abbey.

This acropolis village is built around a castle dating back from the Renaissance period. Layered houses built on the sides of the cliffs, steep little cobblestone streets, flights of steps, small squares with a fountain and town houses. An extraordinary harmony reigns in this stone village.

**Notre Dame of Sénanque Abbey** was a monastery in 1148, you can enjoy all the beauty of the architecture and the Sénanque Valley.

Domaine de Fontenille is one of the few Provençal estates that have kept their original appearance with vineyards as far as the eye can see, the Luberon mountains and Montagne Sainte-Victoire. Moulin Castelas with a tasting of black and green fruity Baux Valley olive oil. In a windmill at the foot of the Château des Baux, Catherine and Jean-Benoît combine skill high standards, technique and all their sensibility as olive-oil producers to make powerful olive oils each year.

#### Visit of the village and castle of Les Baux.

Ranked as one of the "Most Beautiful Villages in France", Les Baux-de-Provence is justifiably considered a prestige site in the Alpilles Regional Nature Park. The castle and gardens overlook the village of Les Baux-de-Provence and form one of the most beautiful historic sites in France. Every year, **"Culturesepaces"** produces a new program of exibition in the quarry named the **"Carrières de lumières"** providing visitors with an intense Art & Music Immersive Experience.



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



#### LES SAINTES-MARIES-DE-LA-MER SANCTUARY OF NOTRE DAME DE LA MER

#### **The sanctuary of Notre Dame de la Mer** is a major site for pilgrimages in May, October and December.

The pilgrims arrive here in large numbers all year round. They come to a sanctuary filled

with two thousand years of prayer, welcomed by Our Lady of the Sea and by the holy women... During the persecution of Christians in 45 A.D., Mary, the wife of Clopas, and Mary Salome fled Palestine and arrived here, on the shores of Camargue, together with Mary Magdalene, Martha, Lazarus, Maximinus and other disciples. They spent the rest of their lives here. The holy women were the first messengers of the Good News of the Resurrection. They were personal witnesses to the Easter event and to Christ's words, which they meditated and passed on to others. Here, in Camargue, they lit the flame of the Christian faith before it spread all over

Gaul and beyond. Visit to the sanctuary of Notre Dame de la Mer, to Saint Sarah''s crypt and to the rampart walk with a wonderful view over the village and Camargue for the Ornithological Park of Pont de Gau visit with the site's owner, Frédéric Lamouroux. A 2-hours walk with a glimpse into the private life of the wild animals living in a 60-hectares natural environment.

#### ROMANESQUE SÉNANQUE ABBEY TO CAVAILLON SYNAGOGUE

The Romanesque Sénanque Abbey was founded in 1148 by Cistercian monks. This truly emblematic

monument of Provence is still the home of a small community of monks and welcomes visitors all the year round. In 1307, King Philip the Fair expelled the Jews from France, in the late 15th century, King Charles VIII expelled them from Provence: only the Comtat Venaissin, part of the Papal States, was still open to them. Tolerance was guite relative, however! Many traces of this fascinating history still exist today, including the synagogue of Cavaillon, now a museum. A visit to the Cavaillon synagogue, a major historical landmark of the Papal Jews and a masterpiece of 18th century Comtat Venaissin art, is one of the town's most fascinating experiences. It was rebuilt in the 18th century to replace the medieval synagogue, threatened with collapse, and always surprises visitors with the blend of details from Jewish and Provencal culture. This is the oldest active synagogue in France. Parts of it date from the 14th century, and it celebrated its 650th anniversary in 2017. It bears witness

to Judeo-Provençal civilisation. The place of worship itself is in 18th century Baroque style, while the ground floor contains older elements such as ritual baths, 2 bakeries and a room dedicated to Jerusalem.

Visit of the Jewish Cemetery of Carpentras, the oldest in the region, and listed as a Historic Monument.

Visit and tasting of Ventoux wines at Château Pesquié.

AVIGNON POPES PALACE, CATHEDRAL AND THE TREASURES OF THE DIOCESE

Presentation of Place "du Palais des Papes," the UNESCO episcopal site The world's biggest Gothic palace, it is both a colossal fortress and a sumptuous palace. Visitors can see twenty-five different areas: large state rooms, treasure rooms, chapels and private apartments with wonderful decorative murals painted by the Italian artist Matteo Giovannetti. During the visit, you will enjoy the privilege of entering Saint Martial's Chapel. For several years this masterpiece of 14th century Italian painting had been closed to the public for reasons of conservation before being restored by a team of Italian experts. It can only be seen through a glass door. You will be seated and enjoy an excellent view of the work with a presentation. **Presentation of masterworks in the Petit Palais Museum.** This museum is in the former Archbishops' Palace. It is dedicated to tribal and Renaissance art and includes a Venus by Botticelli.

Visit to Avignon Cathedral and the treasures of the diocese in the company of Abbé Bréhier. This Romanesque cathedral crowned by a gilded statue of the Virgin Mary stands next to the famous Palais des Papes.

Villeneuve-Lez-Avignon, the city of the Pope's cardinals (10 minutes' drive) to admire the Coronation of the Virgin Enguerrand Quarton at the Pierre de Luxembourg Museum. The altarpiece shows the Virgin Mary being crowned by the Trinity amidst the heavenly host.

At the foot of the impressive cliffs of Sainte Baume, visitors enter a primal forest (dating from the ice age) and begin the climb up to the holy cave, one of the world's oldest Christian monuments. Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume: Visit to Saint Maximin's Basilica (night visit). The basilica stands on a square beside the Royal Convent. It was completed in 1532. This is the most important religious building in Gothic style in Provence. At the end of the crypt a space has been dug out for the reliquary of Saint Mary Magdalene.







#### FORCALQUIER, BARONNIES PROVENÇALES NATURE RESERVE, RIBEYRET, MOYDANS

Visit of the **Convent of the Cordeliers** (13th century) which today houses the European University of Perfumes and Flavors, a center of training, research and promotion dedicated to the valorization of aromatic plants and cosmetics. Then, visit the Artemisia Museum and discover the captivating history of the aromatic and medicinal plants of the Lure Mountain (a Unesco World Heritage Site for its biodiversity).
