



# VÍA DE VACUNACIÓN COMPLETA (VTL)



## Requisitos para un vuelo VTL

Los viajeros deben estar completamente vacunados contra el Covid-19 con cualquier vacuna de la [Lista de Uso de Emergencia de la Organización Mundial de la Salud \(OMS\)](#).

- Certificado de vacunación en inglés expedido por Singapur o por el país del VTL. Todos los certificados de vacunación deben ser verificables digitalmente (es decir, contener un código QR para su verificación).
- PCR 48 horas antes de la salida del vuelo.
- PCR a la llegada al aeropuerto de Changi
- Un seguro de viaje, con una cobertura mínima de 30.000 dólares singapurenses para gastos de tratamiento médico y hospitalización relacionados con el Covid-19, antes de viajar a Singapur.
- Todos los visitantes deben descargarse la aplicación [TraceTogether](#) en Singapur para facilitar la localización de contacto. Después de salir de Singapur, los datos de la aplicación TraceTogether deben conservarse durante 21 días.
- Solicitar un [Pase de Viaje con Vacunación \(VTP\)](#) online entre 7 y 60 días antes de la fecha prevista de entrada en Singapur.

A través del link [Safe Travel Concierge](#) marcando la **casilla "I'm travelling on a VTL"** se puede:

- ver la lista de los requisitos previos al viaje.
- acceder a servicios y formularios electrónicos como la tarjeta de llegada SG/tarjeta de declaración de salud.
- reservar y pagar por su prueba de PCR Covid-19 de la llegada. Los formularios se pueden rellenar y la prueba PCR se puede reservar hasta con tres días de antelación.
